

Health Risks in Today's Cosmetics

Thousands of Americans suffer adverse effects after using off-the-shelf cosmetic products. In a study conducted by the University of California of more than 58,000 hairdressers, manicurists, and cosmetologists revealed that they developed multiple myeloma (cancer) at four times the rate of the general population. This is believed to be due to exposure to cosmetic chemicals. The Natural Skin Care Institute's recent survey of today's cosmetic products reveals surprising results. Over eighty percent of the products on the market today contain one or more ingredients that are documented to cause adverse reactions in humans and animals. Few incidents are reported since affected consumers simply discontinue using the product. Many resulting systemic effects are unknown and remain undiagnosed and an unsuspecting population remains unwarned.
